

Otto M. Schwarz – Composer, Producer, and Musical Visionary

Otto M. Schwarz, born in 1967 in Austria, has been one of the most internationally successful composers of symphonic wind music for more than three decades.

His works are performed in over 80 countries by thousands of ensembles, earning him worldwide recognition as one of the most influential composers in his field.

In addition to his prominent role in wind music, Schwarz is also firmly established in the world of film and media composition.

He has written the music for more than 50 feature films and composed over 4,000 works for documentaries and television productions broadcast internationally. His ability to combine emotional depth, rich orchestral color, and narrative precision makes him a highly sought-after composer across many areas of music production.

Since 1995, his works have been published by renowned publishers such as De Haske, Mitropa, and Hal Leonard.

In 2020, Schwarz founded his own publishing house, **Symphonic Dimensions Publishing**, whose editions are distributed exclusively by **Stretta Music** (Europe) and **J.W. Pepper** (USA & worldwide).

For his outstanding artistic achievements, Otto M. Schwarz has received numerous honors, including the **BUMA International Award (2022)**.

He has also been awarded the **Gold Decoration of Honor of the Province of Lower Austria** and the **Gold Decoration of Honor of the Republic of Austria** for his exceptional contributions to music.
